The season begins when The Riverside Dance Festival arrives at Riverside Theatre on August 6 and August 7, 2021. Ballet Vero Beach is thrilled to present, in partnership with Riverside Theatre, konverjdans to culminate the tenth annual Riverside Dance Festival. konverjdans has beguiled Vero Beach audiences since their debut here in November 2018. Ballet Vero Beach is thrilled to be able to offer our audiences an expanded view of this enigmatic and engaging New York City based troupe. Performances will feature konverjdans artists alongside Ballet Vero Beach's own resident professional dancers.

Following last season's spectacular film adaptation of Nutcracker on the Indian River, we are thrilled to bring our critically acclaimed production back safely to a very different stage this season! Join Ballet Vero Beach for a one-of-a-kind outdoor experience to get up close and personal with an abbreviated version of our beloved version of the holiday classic. The idyllic setting of Tree House Vero Beach will play host to this magical experience on December 21 and 22, 2021. Enjoy a one-hour version of Nutcracker on the Indian River complete with all your favorite characters and choreography! From land crabs to manatees and river otters to bougainvillea, this incarnation of Nutcracker on the Indian River is sure to impress.

Program 1 "Franco-American" on January 14 and 15, 2022, promises a program celebrating eclectic French and American influences on the company. Matthew Lovegood's lush and romantic French Songs returns, Adam Schnell's wistfully youthful Ballade makes its debut on the main stage, and French choreographer Yves de Bouteiller's supremely allegorical West Side Story Suite makes its company debut capping off this rich cross-cultural offering.

Program 2, "Symphonic Dances", will take the stage at the VBHS Performing Arts Center February 25 and 26, 2022. Big and bold scores with dancing to match is the theme of the second program of Ballet Vero Beach' 2021-2022 Season. Adam Schnell's sweeping Pastoral Symphony returns alongside a world premiere by Camilo A. Rodriguez.

Program 3, "Studio to Stage", brings the season to a triumphant close on April 8 and 9, 2022. Ballet Vero Beach's 2021-2022 Season concludes with a program that promises to illicit some of our favorite responses: contented sighs and hearty guffaws! Take a journey with the company from hilarious toiling in the studio to the thrilling heights of technical accomplishment. The supremely classical and ambitious Bournonville Divertissement returns to showcase Danish style at its best, and Peter Anastos brings his comedic skewering of ballet schools everywhere to the Ballet Vero Beach stage in the iconic Ecole de Ballet.
